WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin every eye shall see him.

LENTEN PRACTICES

We journey through Lent with *prayer*, *fasting*, and *works of charity*. Maybe this is a good time to evaluate our daily prayer. Can we adjust our daily routine to include some time of prayer, maybe some time to reflect on the daily Scriptures (included with the bulletin), perhaps we might consider the family Rosary for Lent.

PASCHAL FAST

The Sacred Triduum begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. Catholics are invited to observe these three days with deep devotion. Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence for us. The law of fast applies to Catholics – in good health – who are in their 14th year to the completion of their 59th year. Fasting can take on various forms. A good guide is that the three meals should be smaller in portion size. All Catholics – regardless of age – are to abstain from eating meat on Good Friday. It is a laudable practice to maintain the Paschal Fast through Holy Saturday.

FEDERAL ELECTION

Voting in any election in our nation is a great privilege and an important duty as Canadians. Be sure you are registered to vote on April 28th or in any of the early vote opportunities.

HOLY WEEK SCHEDULE

Please note the schedule of liturgies for Holy ← Week. Note the change in times for Holy Saturday ... there is no 5 pm Mass next Saturday. The Easter Vigil begins at 8:00 pm with the lighting of the new fire outdoors, if possible. The "mother of all vigils" is longer than a usual Sunday Mass, but it is the vigil par excellence - the liturgy at it's best. If you've never been, you'll not be disappointed! Note too: there is only one Mass on Holy Thursday the Mass of the Lord's Supper, with an hour of prayer at the Altar of Repose in McNally Hall after Mass. On Good Friday, we gather at 3 pm for the liturgy commemorating the Lord's Passion and Death - the Eucharist is not celebrated, but the reception of Holy Communion (consecrated on Holy Thursday evening) is offered to the faithful. On Holy Saturday the only Mass offered is the Solemn Easter Vigil. Funeral Masses are not celebrated on Holy Thursday, Good Friday or Holy Saturday. They are either scheduled for Easter Week or a liturgy of the Word - without Mass is observed for the deceased and their family and friends.
