# **WELCOME!**

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin *every eye shall see him*.

#### NEW PASTORAL YEAR

The start of a new school year also marks the beginning of a new pastoral year for our Parish community. Activities and programmes will begin again. Welcome back to all. Our Parish Finance Council and Pastoral Council resume their meetings schedules after a summer break. The liturgical year continues through the final third of Ordinary Time.

Pastoral Council Meetings (2025 – 2026) September 20, November 15, April 18, June 13.

Finance Council Meetings (2025 – 2026) October 18, February 7, June 13.

The current three-year term for members of both the Pastoral Council and Finance Council end on May 31, 2026. Re-appointment of current members and/or the appointment of new members will take effect on June 1, 2026, for a three-year term ending May 31, 2029 – or upon the appointment of a new Rector.

The Cathedral Basilica hosts many celebrations and events in the life of the Diocese of Hamilton. The weekly bulletin will have details of these events as they take place in the coming year.

Among the major events will be the installation of a new Bishop for the Diocese of Hamilton once one is appointed by Pope Leo XIV. We have no idea when that will be or who it will be. Bishop Crosby submitted his resignation as required by Canon Law on his 75th birthday (June 2024). The process of selecting a new Bishop has been initiated by the Apostolic Nuncio (Pope's ambassador to Canada) and will conclude with an announcement by the Holy See - possibly this Fall or early in the New Year. We pray for Bishop Crosby in this time of transition to retirement, and we pray that the candidate selected to be our new Bishop will accept the appointment relying on the grace of the Good Shepherd for strength and guidance.
