#### **WELCOME!**

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin *every eye shall see him.*

#### CWL MONTHLY MEETING

Congratulations to Karen Felker the new President and her executive who will serve a two-year term. Structural changes have been made to CWL Executives at all levels – including the Parish level.

#### POPE FRANCIS ON THE LITURGY

On February 8, Pope Francis met with the Dicastery for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments. In his address he offered these remarks on the importance of liturgical formation for the clergy and for the whole people of God.

"The goal of the liturgical reform – within the broader framework of the renewal of the Church – is precisely to bring to life the kind of formation of the faithful and ministry of pastors that will have their summit and source in the liturgy (Inter Oecumenici, 26 September 1964, #5).

For all this to happen, therefore, liturgical formation is necessary, i.e. for the liturgy and by the liturgy, about which you are reflecting in these days. We are not talking about the specialisation of a few experts, but an interior disposition of the entire people of God. This, of course, does not exclude those who, by virtue of the sacrament of Holy Orders, are called to be mystagogues, that is, to take the faithful by the hand and accompany them into understanding the sacred mysteries, I encourage you to continue your efforts so that pastors know how to lead people into the rich pastures of liturgical celebration, where the proclamation of Christ dead and risen becomes a concrete experience of his life-transforming presence."

*It is significant that the first Constitution approved* by Pope St. Paul VI and the fathers of the Second Vatican Council, was the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy. The reform of the Roman Rite had been underway for nearly 100 years prior to the Council. The Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy is the fruit of that important work. It also formed the foundation for the Council's understanding of the Church the other Constitutions and Declarations of the Council which opened in 1962 and concluded in 1965. As we approach the 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the close of Vatican II, we will have opportunities to reflect on the content of its documents. Pope Francis has called the whole Church to prepare for the Holy Year of Hope (2025) by reflecting on the Council's four major Constitutions - Liturgy, Church, Word of God and the Church in the Modern World.
