#### **WELCOME!**

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a Minor Basilica by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's Coat of Arms presents a shield sheltered by the ombrellino, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin every eye shall see him.

#### **BISHOP CROSBY RETIRES**

His Excellency, Bishop Crosby will solemnly close the Jubilee Year on **Sunday**, **December 28** with Mass at **3:00 p.m.** in the Cathedral

Basilica of Christ the King. That Mass will also be offered in thanksgiving for Bishop Crosby's ministry as our Diocesan Bishop these past 15 years. All are welcome.



#### WELCOME BISHOP

In accepting Bishop Crosby's resignation, the Holy Father appointed Bishop Joseph Dabrowski as Bishop of Hamilton. His Excellency is a member of the Michaelite Fathers (a

missionary order serving Polish Catholics outside Poland). Most of his Priestly service was offered in the Diocese of London, Ontario. He was appointed Auxiliary Bishop of London in 2015 and then Bishop of Charlottetown, PEI in 2023. Bishop Dabrowski will be installed as Bishop of Hamilton on **Monday, February 2, 2026** during a Solemn Mass offered in the Cathedral Basilica at 11:00 a.m. We pray for our new Bishop as he concludes his ministry in Charlottetown and prepares to move to Hamilton. Welcome and prayers for your Excellency's ministry among us.
