WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin *every eye shall see him*.

SUNDAY MISSALS 2026

New Sunday Missals for 2026 will be available on Sunday, November 16 on a first some basis. We ask a minimum \$2 donation which you may place in the Sunday collection on November 16.

SUNDAY OFFERING ENVELOPES

Sunday Offering Envelopes for 2026 will be available in December. If you would like to **begin** using envelopes in 2026, kindly complete a Parish Registration form either on-line or on paper (forms located in the Tower entrance). For all our supporters, how much to put in the envelope is entirely your decision. Some choose to offer the first hour of their work week to God, others may opt for a different calculation. Whatever you can afford. At the end of the year, you will receive a donation receipt for a charitable deduction on your tax return.

As a convenience, our Parish offers *pre-Authorized Debits* (PAD) to contribute monthly by having your pre-determined about deducted from your bank account ... at no charge to you. A monthly gift of \$40 (\$10/week); \$100 (\$25/week) provides the Parish with a steady flow of income. It also reduces the Sunday morning "scramble" for cash to put in an envelope. Annual donation receipts are offered for these donations too. To sign up for PAD please complete a Parish Registration Form.

The Parish is also able to receive gifts of investment shares. You may wish to contact the Office of Stewardship for the Diocese (905) 528-7988 for more information.
