stopping at most parishes around the island for specific prayers. The prayers are usually done in melodic, mournful chant. Each night they are lodged by families of the town, where they stay overnight. each they stay overnight, here at St. Michael's church this tradition is kept alive, albeit a mini version of it. The pilgrimage\Romaria is led by a gentleman whose title is the Master of the Romeiros and is sr. José Correia. The Romaria \pilgrimage is planned for March 16 at 1pm.
