

According to the rich tradition of São Miguel in the Azores, during the Lenten season pilgrims (romeiros) leave their home parishes and walk on foot around the island. The journey lasts seven days, stopping at most parishes for special Lenten prayers.

These prayers have a penitential tone and are expressed in a melodic, mournful chant. Each night, the pilgrims are welcomed by families in the parishes or stay in community centres.

This beautiful tradition continues here at St. Michael's Parish. The pilgrimage (Romaria) is led by the Master (Mestre) of the Romeiros, Sr. José Correia.

Lives in the village of Piquiá de Baixo in Brazil began being disrupted in the 1980s, with the arrival of several polluting industries in their backyard. The villagers formed an association to defend their rights. Flavia's father started the fight, and she picked up the torch. Last year, after a 20year struggle, 312 families affected by industrial pollution moved to the new, cleaner, safer village of Piquiá da Conquista. The support of Development and Peace — Caritas Canada's partner, Justiça nos Trilhos (JnT), made this relocation possible for 1,300 people. 
