## *As a Catholic, why support this Fund?*

For over 100 years, the Catholic Church worked for the federal government as the largest operator of residential schools for Indigenous people in Canada. During those years, across the country, there were many documented cases of abuse of all types. The discovery of a possible graveyard in a former residential school in Kamloops triggered the start of this new journey between the Church and the Indigenous People of this land. While the specifics of that discovery and other known, but unmarked, cemeteries across the country are important, more important is the damage done to generations of children in the schools themselves. These were government organized schools, but the Church agreed to participate in their administration and shares responsibility for what happened. This includes the forcible suppression of Indigenous language and culture, neglect, malnourishment, poor health care, assault and abuse.

We ask you to help us support our brothers and sisters who share this land with us, to honour our commitments and make positive change for these communities. Let us all pray for a successful campaign and a prosperous future for all.

## ***What are we doing?***

We are embarking on a journey of healing. This journey is about hope for the future and recovery from the traumas of the past. It needs your support. We can help local Indigenous communities in the Diocese regain and build their traditional culture and language, celebrate their strengths and their heritage as they recover from the past and build for the future. With your support we can make a difference.

The Catholic Church in Canada is committed to walking with Indigenous people to a better future. The Diocese of London has committed to raise \$1.8 million over the next five years for this important work. We will be funding initiatives in the

Diocese to preserve Indigenous culture and spirituality, strengthen communities, protect language, and support families.

As Pope Francis said on his penitential pilgrimage to Canada in 2022, *"I've come to Canada as a pilgrim to walk with you and for the Indigenous Peoples so that progress may be made in the search for truth, in the processes of healing and reconciliation, and so that seeds of hope be sown for Indigenous and non-Indigenous people who want to live fraternally."*

## ***What will your donation do?***

Your gift will help Indigenous communities flourish. We have reached out to the eight First Nations and the Métis Council in our area, as well as to organizations and agencies that support Indigenous people, asking them to

submit proposals for projects and programs that we can support financially, if they fit the criteria set by Canada's bishops with input from Indigenous advisors. The diocesan Truth and Reconciliation Committee will review all applications. Those approved will be forwarded to the Board of the National Indigenous Reconciliation Fund for the final approval needed to release the funds. Projects funded so far:

### **1) Thames Bluewater Métis Council Annual Rendezvous**

The Rendezvous brings together the Métis citizens of the Council area to reconnect and celebrate their culture through workshops, entertainment, food, and knowledge sharing.

### **2) Kettle and Stoney Point First Nation - Giwayshkodayaang (The Place Where You Come Home to the Fire)**

The Place Where You Come Home to the Fire reflects the importance for Canada's Indigenous people of returning to a way of life that invokes connection to original teachings and to Mother Earth and Spirit.

Giwayshkodayaang comprises four (4) core components, including the: 1) Mental Health and Wellness Hub; 2) Land-Based Healing Program; 3) Recovery Home; and 4) Emergency Overnight Shelter and Daytime Drop-In. The program serves to both prevent and treat those suffering from mental health, addiction and violence challenges, allowing them access to alternative options to healing that complement existing western approaches.

### **3) Oneida Nation of the Thames - Healing and Rebuilding Through Culturally Appropriate Communication**

This project supports the Nation's work to help Oneida through culturally appropriate communication within the community and outside of it. The program supports

communications that are grounded in culture, healing, and reconciliation, and can be used with the community's youth population.

### **4) Northern Bridge - In Person & Virtual Counselling, Systems and Support Programming for Indigenous Communities Affected by Residential Schools Systems**

A London-based organization that provides consistent counselling and programming in the Athabasca region due to limited access to physical health and mental health services, as well as limits on travel and service providers' abilities to travel to remote communities.

### **5) Nokee Kwe Positive Voice Project**

Nokee Kwe's Positive Voice project involves fostering connections and relations among Indigenous women, increasing visibility and support networks, and dispelling myths about victimhood through storytelling and cultural exhibits. Additionally, the program aims to pass on learned skills to families and communities to create a ripple effect of safe spaces. Positive Voice is a comprehensive initiative that not only empowers Indigenous women but also aims to create lasting positive change within their communities by fostering resilience, challenging stereotypes, and promoting safety and support networks.
