

For this reason, he was asked to offer atonement for the dead for the delivery of their sin." 2 Mac 12:46

Every Mass is a wonderful gift of God to us! The practice of requesting a Mass to be offered for loved ones, living or deceased, is a beautiful and meaningful part of our Catholic tradition. Any individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the Holy Souls in Purgatory, for the intentions of another person still living, or as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. One must never forget the infinite graces that flow from the Sacrifice of the Mass which benefit one's soul.

- We will ensure a Mass will be said for all intentions that are requested.
 It is not possible for all those Masses to be said in our parishes.
- At our Parishes many people request Mass intentions.

To allow everyone to have an opportunity to be present at Masses for their loved ones, 2 intentions (up to 3 names for each intention) may be requested by a person to be said in our parish family every 6 months

- Jan June opens in November
- June Dec opens in April
- You are welcome to ask for as many more intentions as you like! Those additional Masses will be said by priests that Fr Tom and Fr Nelson know. For example, mission priests who depend on the intentions to support their work, or retired priests who are grateful for the opportunity to continue to pray for people.
- When possible, it is preferred that Mass intentions be booked in person or by phone by the
 person requesting them.
- Only the name of the person/people being prayed for will be published and read, and never the reason for the intention (birthday, anniversary, etc.) or the person requesting the intention.
- If a family member from another town or country has recently passed away, the name will be
 added to the Prayers of the Faithful for a memorial Mass (regularly scheduled daily Mass) at the
 request of the family.
- Mass requests will be granted as close to the requested date and time as possible.
 If it is not possible to comply with the primary request, the next closest date will be scheduled.
- The date of a Mass Intention is always subject to change.

In parish life, things sometimes come up unexpectedly, and if that happens, your Mass intention may be moved. We will call you to choose another date as close to the original date as possible.

- Queremos vos assegurar que todd a missa requisitada será celebrada.
 - Náo será possivel rezar todas as intençós nas nossas paróquias.
- Nas nossas paróquias há muitos pedidos de missas e por isso temos estas régras. Afim de tentar a satisfazer tantos pedido recomendamos o seguinte.
- Duas inteções por famíla e cada intenção pode ter 3 nome de seis em seis meses.
- · De janeiro a Junho
- De Junho a Dezembro.

Podem pedir mais intenções de missas fora da cota. Porém estas missas serão celebradas e enviadas para missionários que dependem delas para sobreviver. O Pe. Tom e Nelson as encomendarão aos sacerdotes missionários.

- O pedido de missas quando possível deve ser feito em pessoa ou por telefone pela própria pessoa.
- Todos os pedidos de missas não efetuados pela prórpria pessoa, serão enviadas aos missionários.
- Notem que daqui por diante, o nome da intenção da missa serã mencionado sem addicionar mais nada como: Primeiro aniversário our quinto etc.
- Se um membro da família faleceu em outra freguesia ou país, podemos adicionar o nome a uma das missas.
- Pedidos de datas para as missas serão honradas na medida que for possível, ou na mais próxima data do pedido.
- Notem que as datas de missas s\u00e3o sujeitas a altera\u00f3\u00f3es. Na vida de uma par\u00e3quia e de um sacerdote muito pode acontecer e urg\u00e9ncias surgem que exigem altera\u00f3\u00e3es. Ligaremos para si a avisar as altera\u00e7\u00e3es.
