## **ST. MICHAEL'S LEAMINGTON SOCIETY OF SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL NEWSLETTER NOVEMBER 2025**

The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul's St. Michael's Leamington Conference operates a food bank out of the basement of St. Michael's church. Its 35 members and volunteers put in an average of 400 hours/month helping an average of 130 families/month. Thanks to our shoppers' diligence and with the help of local grocery stores, we are able to keep monthly food costs to around \$4,000. Our Conference also helps with providing beds and vouchers for clothing and home supplies.



Our food bank is open once a week. Families can ask for assistance every four weeks. They receive bread, milk, eggs, margarine, apples, potatoes, vegetables, cereal, juice, peanut butter, jam, macaroni & cheese, oatmeal, pancake mix, pasta and pasta sauce, tuna, soup, tea & coffee, rice, baked beans, chick peas, lentils, and kidney beans. We also make home visits and deliveries as necessary.

We recently topped up a donation of 25 backpacks with 50 additional ones loaded with school supplies and gave these to families with school age children.



Giving Trees at St. Michael's and Our Lady of Blessed Sacrament will soon be set up to help fill Christmas hampers.

None of this would be possible without the support of our donors and the help of our volunteers.

*Frederic Ozanam*

Societe de Saint-Vincent de Paul, Catholic organization dedicated to works of charity. It was founded in 1833 by Frederic Ozanam, a 20-year-old Sorbonne student in Paris. Ozanam and 6 other students formed the society in response to taunts that Christianity had outlived its usefulness, especially to the poor. The students put themselves under the patronage of St Vincent de Paul, who had called attention to social problems 200 years before, and set themselves to bringing assistance to the poor. The conference grew to more than 200 members in the first year and soon spread to the provinces of France and to Rome (1842), England (1844), Germany (1846) and throughout Europe. Dr Joseph Painchaud joined the conference in Paris, and on returning home to Ou6bec in 1846 founded the Notre-Dame Conference. Conferences were organized in Montreal (1848), Toronto (1850) and throughout British North America. The efforts of the Vtncentians have been focused on the parish level, although some conferences are formed for specific purposes or places, such as jails, schools or homes for the aged. Its main objectives are to encourage "the practice of Christian living, " to visit, help and bring comfort to the poor and infirm. Today the society functions in 145 countries, with a membership of over one million. In Canada there are some 950 conferences with over 10 000 members

**ST. JOHN DE BREBEUF SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL  
NEWSLETTER, NOVEMBER, 2025**



The St. John de Brebeuf Conference has been very busy serving the needy of our Parish and Community. We currently have 10 active members who meet for about an hour once a month. We pray together and plan how we can bring the love of Jesus to the poor.

The Conference operates a Food Bank from the basement of the Church. We are available to assist people from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Tuesday to Friday. Groups of 2 members usually take incoming calls from anyone who needs assistance. Those who cannot make it to the Church will be visited by them.

The needy can receive support generally once a month. We provide non perishable food, a Fresco food card for fresh groceries, and other necessities such as clothing and furniture vouchers.



Other projects our Conference is involved in include: The St. John de Brebeuf school can drives, Christmas gift cards for the poor, a tax clinic, reception for migrant workers after the June Spanish Mass, the Feast of St. Vincent de Paul can drive, and the Sleepwalk bed fundraiser where we obtain beds for those in need.
