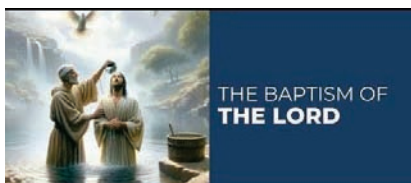
First Saturday Promise:

"Behold, my daughter, my Heart encircled with thorns, with which ungrateful people pierce It at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude. Give me consolation, you, at least; and make known on my behalf that I promise to assist at the hour of death, with the graces necessary for salvation, all who on the First Saturday of five consecutive months: 1) confess their sins, 2) receive Holy Communion, 3) recite five decades of the Rosary, 4) keep me company for fifteen minutes meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, 5) and have the intention of making reparation to my Immaculate Heart."

(Our Lady of Fatima's message to Lucia)

THE BAPTISM OF THE LORD



When the Lord Jesus went to the Jordan River to be baptized, St. John the Baptist knew that Jesus did not need baptism.

He was astonished (perhaps even horrified) by Jesus' request, saying: *"I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?"* St. John the Baptist, Matthew 3:14

Our Lord answered him:

"Let it be so now; for thus it is fitting for us to fulfil all righteousness." Jesus, Matthew 3:15

Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist not for his own sins, but to **fulfill all righteousness**, publicly inaugurate His ministry as God's Son, identify with sinful humanity, and set an example for His followers, symbolizing His acceptance of God's will and the path to His atoning death on the cross.

Key Reasons for Jesus' Baptism:

1. **Fulfilling Righteousness:** Jesus stated it was fitting to be baptized "to fulfill all righteousness," aligning Himself with God's plan and demonstrating perfect obedience.
2. **Public Identification:** It publicly launched His mission, with God the Father affirming, "This is my beloved Son," and the Holy Spirit descending like a dove, signifying His divine identity.
3. **Symbolizing Union with Sinners:** By entering the water where others confessed sins, Jesus symbolically took on humanity's guilt, foreshadowing His ultimate sacrifice on the cross for humanity's sins.
4. **Setting an Example:** As a model teacher, Jesus showed His followers the path to a new life and obedience, demonstrating the importance of baptism.
5. **Anticipating the Cross:** The watery descent into the Jordan is seen as an anticipation of His descent into death (the "baptism" of the cross) and subsequent resurrection.

PRAYER:

Eternal Father, who at the baptism of Jesus revealed Him to be Your Son, anointing Him with the Holy Spirit: grant that we may be faithful to our call as Children of God, listening to you, guided by Your Spirit, to fulfil our unique and definite purpose. Amen.

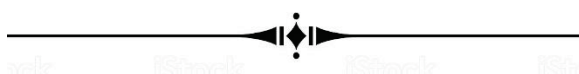
