First Saturday Promise:

"Behold, my daughter, my Heart encircled with thorns, with which ungrateful people pierce It at every moment by their blasphemies and ingratitude. Give me consolation, you, at least; and make known on my behalf that I promise to assist at the hour of death, with the graces necessary for salvation, all who on the First Saturday of five consecutive months: 1) confess their sins, 2) receive Holy Communion, 3) recite five decades of the Rosary, 4) keep me company for fifteen minutes meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, 5) and have the intention of making reparation to my Immaculate Heart."

> (Our Lady of Fatima's message to Lucia) First Saturday Masses are held at 8:00 am each month at St. Ambrose Church.



June is known as the month of the **Sacred Heart of Jesus**. The feast dates back to 1673, when a French nun, belonging to the Order of the Visitation of Holy Mary (Visitandines)

in eastern France, began to receive visions about the Sacred Heart.

Jesus appeared to Sister Margaret Mary Alacoque and revealed ways to venerate His Sacred Heart and explained the immense love He has for humanity, appearing with His heart visible outside His chest, on fire, and surrounded by a crown of thorns.

These different ways include partaking in a holy hour on Thursdays and the reception of the Eucharist on the first Friday of every month.

Jesus told Sister Margaret Mary, "My Sacred Heart is so intense in its love for men, and for you in particular, that not being able to contain within it the flames of its ardent charity, they must be transmitted through all means." These visions continued for 18 months.

On June 16, 1675, Jesus told Sister Margaret Mary to promote a feast that honoured His Sacred Heart. He also gave Sister Margaret Mary twelve promises made to all who venerated and promoted the devotion of the Sacred Heart.

Jesus said, "I ask of you that the Friday after the Octave of Corpus Christi be set apart for a special feast to honor my heart, by communicating on that day, and making reparation to it by a solemn act, in order to make amends for the indignities which it has received during the time it has been exposed on the altars. I promise you that my heart shall expand itself to shed in abundance the influence of its divine love upon those who shall thus honor it, and cause it to be honoured."

Sister Margaret Mary died in 1690 and was canonized by Pope Benedict XV on May 13, 1920.

The Vatican granted the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to France in 1765.

In 1856, Pope Pius IX designated the Friday following the Feast of Corpus Christi as the Feast of the Sacred Heart for the universal Church.

Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ

In some ways every Sunday is a feast of the Eucharist,

because by participating in the Mass, and in receiving Communion, we are honoring and celebrating the Eucharist. A desire to specifically celebrate the Eucharist developed. The feast of Corpus Christi owes a rather large debt to St. Juliana, a nun of Liege, Belgium, who was led to start a celebration of the Mass around AD 1230. At an early age, she developed a strong devotion to the Blessed Sacrament, and she longed for a feast in honor of the Eucharist. In AD 1264 Pope Urban IV commanded a universal observance of the feast. However, Urban's death delayed the adoption of the feast. By the 14th century, the feast became universally celebrated in the West. St. Thomas Aguinas is given credit for many of the customs and hymns associated with Corpus Christi. Scholars have disputed this. However, the hymns and prayers certainly are in the tradition of Aquinas, and many defend the traditional ascription based on internal evidence. The Feast of Corpus Christi is celebrated throughout the Catholic Church.
