Give me consolation, you, at least; and make known on my behalf that I promise to assist at the hour of death, with the graces necessary for salvation, all who on the First Saturday of five consecutive months: 1) confess their sins, 2) receive Holy Communion, 3) recite five decades of the Rosary, 4) keep me company for fifteen minutes meditating on the mysteries of the Rosary, 5) and have the intention of making reparation to my Immaculate Heart."

First Saturday Masses are held at 8:00 am each month at St. Ambrose Church.

All Saints' Day, November 1st, is celebrated to honour all saints and martyrs who have attained heaven, both known and unknown, and to recognize their role in the Christian faith. It's a day for us to reflect on the communion of saints, finding inspiration and guidance in their holy lives, and pray for their intercession.

These are the primary reasons for the Celebration:

Honoring Holy Lives:

All Saints' Day commemorates the lives of people who lived in accordance with Christian teachings and are believed to be in heaven.

• Inspiration and Example:

The lives of saints serve as examples for the faithful, showing that it's possible to live a devout and joyful life even amidst the troubles and temptations of life.

• Communion of Saints:


The day celebrates the spiritual bond between the living, the dead, and those in heaven, affirming that they are all connected through Christ.

• Intercession and Guidance:

We believe saints can intercede on behalf of the living, and All Saints' Day is an opportunity to acknowledge their role as powerful intercessors.

All Souls' Day is observed on November 2nd to commemorate and pray for the souls of the deceased, who we believe to be in purgatory. The day allows the living to assist these souls in their journey toward heaven through prayer and Masses. The commemoration is rooted in our belief that a spiritual bond exists between the living, the saints in heaven, and the faithful departed.

Many countries have various traditions for All Souls Day. But one common thread is visiting the graves of our deceased to pray for their souls, adorn the graves with flowers, and pay our respect.




