Advent

This Sunday, we begin our new liturgical calendar with the 1st Sunday of Advent. At the beginning of the Mass, we bless the Advent wreath and we light the first candle of the wreath.

The Advent wreath is rich in symbols. The four candles represent the four weeks of Advent in which we prepare for the celebration of the birth of Jesus. The circular wreath symbolizes the eternity of God who is without beginning or end, and that He loves us with an everlasting love. The evergreens of holly and pine represent our hope in the saving love of God, a hope which is fulfilled in the birth of the Saviour and the hope of eternal salvation.

As Advent progresses, from the 1st week to the 4th week, the number of candles are lighted accordingly. This has a profound spiritual meaning in that Jesus, the light of the world is coming to scatter the darkness of our sins and with each passing week, the light of the candles in the Advent wreath grows brighter in preparation to celebrate the birth of Jesus, the True Light.

Jesus wants to come into our lives with His light and blessings. He wants to bring us healing from the darkness of our sins and help us be reconciled with one another especially in the family. He wants to be in our families so that we can experience His love and joy and peace with each other. But we must invite Him. The Advent wreath would be the means to bring the family together in prayer and to let the light of Christ shine in our hearts and bring about the warmth of love and peace that we always wanted for our families and for ourselves.

Therefore, what we need is: to stay awake and be vigilant in prayer. Lighting the candles of the Advent wreath and praying together as a family may be a small and humble act but the blessings that Jesus gives will be bountiful.

Let us asks ourselves: what will we do during this Advent season to prepare ourselves to celebrate the birth of Jesus? *Fr. Aeqidius Warsito SCJ*
