

Vocation to the Priesthood

Dear brothers and sisters, on March 3, 2023, the Vatican Newspaper, *L'Osservatore Romano*, reported the latest statistics of the global Catholic Church, collected at the end of 2021. According to the report, the number of Catholics worldwide increased by 16.2 million compared to the previous year. However, the total number of priests in the world decreased by 0.57% to 407,872. Two continents that experienced a significant decline were Europe (down by 3,632) and America (down by 963). From the data, we can see that there is a significant gap between the need for services and the availability of priests.

Beloved brothers and sisters, the overview of global Catholic Church statistics invites us to think about the future of our Church, especially concerning the vocation to the priesthood. The liturgical readings today also encourage us to reflect on this calling. The first reading tells the story of the calling of Samuel. Initially, Samuel doubted the call of the Lord. He heard the call but remained uncertain. Three times the Lord called Samuel until he was truly convinced that the call originated from the Lord and he followed it.

Today's Gospel also recounts the calling of the first disciples of Jesus. Andrew, who had met the Messiah, shared the good news with his brother Simon Peter. Andrew brought Peter to Jesus and eventually, both of them followed Jesus. Today's readings urge us to expand the call of the Lord. Perhaps we know someone currently doubting their calling, like the story of Samuel. Our task is to be like the prophet Elijah and Andrew, to reassure that calling and encourage more people to follow Jesus more closely.

Some tangible actions we can take in responding to the needs of the Church are, firstly, to encourage and promote the vocation to the priesthood among our family members and relatives. Secondly, to pray for the growth of vocations worldwide. Thirdly, to support the formation and education process of aspiring priests, both in prayer and financially. By doing these three things, we all participate in ensuring the future sustainability of our Church. Therefore, the question for us is, "Am I moved to pay attention to the needs of the Church? What efforts am I making to provide support and attention to the vocation to the priesthood?"
