Corpus Christi

Young Adults for Christ

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, or the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. One theme of the readings is blood.

In the 1st Reading, the Covenant between God and His people was sealed with the blood of bulls. It was quite a sight as we can imagine, as the blood was cast on the altar and also on the people. But the meaning of "sealed in blood" is profoundly clear. God and His people were bonded by the symbol of blood as Moses declared: "See the blood of the covenant that the Lord has made with you."

Meanwhile, the 2nd Reading tells us of a new Covenant that is also sealed in blood. But it is not the blood of goats or bulls, but the blood of Christ. Christ is the high priest of the new Covenant, and with His own Blood He gained our eternal redemption as He offered Himself as the perfect sacrifice to God through the eternal Spirit. And in the Gospel, we heard how Jesus offered Himself as the perfect sacrifice at the Last Supper, as He gave His Body and Blood to His disciples. It was a sacrifice that was fulfilled on the Cross. Jesus gave Himself, His Body to us to be in union with Him and He poured out His Blood to wash us clean of sin so that we could be saved.

In short, Jesus has shed His Blood for our forgiveness, so that we don't have to shed our own blood in order to be forgiven. And neither should any more blood be shed out of revenge or hatred, or even out of anger and resentment. When we give in to anger, resentment and bitterness, we drain out the blood of life in us as well as in others. Even more, there shouldn't be thoughts of hatred and revenge.

Therefore, let us always remember that as we partake of the Body of Christ in Holy Communion, the Blood of Christ also flows into us and gives us new life and washes our sins away. When we truly understand the spiritual meaning of the Body and Blood of Christ, then we will always want to be in union with Christ Our Saviour and with each other in love and forgiveness, so that as the Body of Christ, we can offer life and salvation to the world.


