**Welcome to Pope Leo XIV!**

Cardinal Robert Francis Prevost of the United States was elected the 267<sup>th</sup> pope on May 8, 2025, and stepped onto the balcony of St. Peter's Basilica as the new leader of the world's 1.4 billion Catholics. He's now known as **Pope Leo XIV**. Born in 1955 in Chicago, Illinois, he is the **first US-born Pope in history**. He is a past provincial prior for the Augustinian Province in Chicago and also previously served as a missionary in Peru (he was also Bishop of the diocese of Chiclayo, Peru since 2015). In his first words to the people, the new pope said, speaking in Italian, "We still have the sound in our ears of the weak voice of Pope Francis who was blessing Rome here. Giving his blessing to the world on that day of Easter Sunday. Allow me to continue that same blessing. God loves everyone. Evil will not prevail. We are all in the hands of God. So without fear, united, hand in hand, with God in ourselves, we go forward." He added: "We are disciples of Christ ... the world needs his light. Humanity needs him." Leo then thanked his predecessor. May we all build bridges with dialogue ... so that we can all be one people in peace. Thank you, Pope Francis." Pope Leo XIV said he wants this message of peace to "enter your hearts, to reach your families and all people, wherever they are." He urged the faithful to "move forward, without fear, united, hand in hand with God and with each other." The new pope called for the light of Christ to serve "as the bridge" to God's love.



**Cardinal Leo's Message on the Election of Pope Leo XIV**

With hearts filled with joy and deep gratitude, we celebrate the election of our new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV. I was most humbled and grateful to participate in the conclave these last few days. It was both moving and profound to gather together and invoke the assistance of the Holy Spirit for this most serious ecclesial discernment made by the College of Cardinals. We felt truly supported by your prayers and those of so many Catholics throughout the world. Thank you for your prayerful contribution to this supreme act of Catholic faith. I invite the faithful in the Archdiocese of Toronto to be united in faith and devotion, interceding earnestly each day for His Holiness, just as we do at every Mass, lifting him up in our prayer intentions. Let us be obedient and loving to this Servant of the Servants of God, supporting his leadership and shepherding ministry for the growth of the Church, walking along the path of holiness. May the reign of our beloved Pope Leo XIV be marked by peace, communion, and a renewed commitment to carrying the saving message of Christ to all corners of the earth, reaching every heart, touching every life, strengthening every family. May he be a visible source of unity in the Catholic and Apostolic faith and of communion for the entire Christian people.
