

# **A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:**

Recently my friend Father Steve Lape called me, and we were talking about religious movies. In all the parishes which he has been assigned to, Father Lape has always had a program once a month called Faith and Film night. Each month he shows a film followed by the audience engaging in a discussion about the faith aspects of the film. These nights have been well received in all his parishes, and they truly bring people together.

He was telling me that for the last two months he has shown the 1977 television production of Jesus of Nazareth which starred Robert Powell as Jesus. I remember watching it with my parents and my grandmother at her place in London. It made a strong impression on me, and I watched it again when it was broadcast again a couple of years later. It was divided into four parts, so it is quite long, but still a powerful interpretation of the Life of Christ. Father Lape mentioned that it is his favourite film on the Life of Christ.

As I mentioned earlier, I have not seen this film in over 40 years, but I made a point to look it up on YouTube and view some scenes of the film. I deliberately watched the scene depicting our Gospel passage for this Fifth Sunday of Lent. In the film the role of the woman caught in adultery was played by Claudia Cardinale, an Italian actress. The scene played out, is powerful in its depiction of the terror the woman in the Gospel was experiencing. In the scene, Christ is portrayed writing on the ground and basically not appearing to show any interest in the woman's plight. He of course challenges the mob to cast the first stone if they have not sinned. Obviously, the crowd disperses one by one, and Robert Powell is left alone with Claudia Cardinale. He tells her to sin no more and to go on her way, which she does. Very powerful in its interpretation of the Gospel passage, the film still holds up well to this very day.

I have always wondered, and was wondering again after watching the scene, what Jesus wrote on the ground? Many scholars have speculated that it was probably nothing. Some have thought that Jesus was so furious with the crowd and their actions that he was basically counting to ten while drawing. It was not what He wrote that silenced the crowd, it was how He did it. Jesus made the crowd face itself. We must face ourselves as well. It is a national sport to judge and criticize those in the public eye and in everyday occurrences with family and others, however; we are called to be followers and imitators of Christ. We are all in sales. We must sell and promote the Christian way of life especially with Easter approaching.

If you are able to watch Jesus of Nazareth with Easter near, I encourage you to do so. It can bring forward numerous questions about the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Christ.
