# A Word From Our Pastor:

ust as the First Sunday of Lent always tells the story of Jesus being tempted by Satan, the Church always presents the Transfiguration on the Second Sunday of Lent, whereby we read about how Jesus showed His glory to Peter, James, and John.

Not to downplay the significance of the Transfiguration, I would like to focus this bulletin message on the first reading of this Sunday; Abraham and his son Isaac.

I can remember sitting in St. Joseph's Hospital with my parents and reading this story in a children's Bible which was in the waiting room. I can remember being scared and disturbed about this passage. Every time I was in that waiting room, I would re-read the story to convince myself that it was a Bible passage.

It seems incredible to us that God would ask Abraham for his firstborn son, Isaac as a child sacrifice. We must remember that at least in part this would have been in keeping with Abraham's faith. The firstborn of all creatures belonged to God. God had a right to them. The Scriptures tell us of parents who took their firstborn sons to the Temple to present them to the priests. On occasion the sons were kept at the Temple to assist the priests. A practice developed to 'redeem' the child by offering animal sacrifice. This is exactly what Joseph and Mary did, an act we celebrate on the Feast of the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple.

What is notable is that Abraham was noted for arguing with God, disagreeing with God and on occasion he would even bargain with God. In this instance, however, Abraham did not utter a word. To Abraham, everything he believed and trusted in was based on his relationship with God.

We know the story, we know that God relented, we know that Abraham was rewarded for his loyalty to God by being blessed with descendants. So, during this Lent, as we examine our own loyalty to God, we should ask: "Am I willing to sacrifice the present and thus my future for the sake of something greater?" We are in a season of sacrifice. Have we examined exactly how much we are willing or able to sacrifice for God? Giving up everything we know and usually trust for a future with God is challenging.

Abraham passed his test of faithfulness. During Lent we are called to be tested as well in our faith to God. How we measure up is a very important aspect of our relationship with God.
