

A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

was debating this week on what I was going to put into this Sunday's bulletin. The Gospel for this Sunday is the beautiful image of Jesus' teaching His disciples how to pray using the words of the Our Father. Proper prayer allows us to grow in our relationship with God.

This is also the weekend that we as a Church celebrate the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. This day was established by Pope Francis in 2015, I believe, to coincide with the memorial of St. Anne and St. Joachim, the parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This memorial is always celebrated on July 26th.

Pope Francis instituted this World Day by reminding the faithful of the importance Grandparents and the Elderly in our society. Grandparents, in particular, play an important role because if they are serious about their faith lives, then they set the tone for the other generations in the family in the development of their own faith lives.

Many of us can attest that when we were children, our grandparents were, in many ways, our first teachers of the Faith. I can remember personally, my grandmother taking me to Mass on Sundays at Sacred Heart Church in Hamilton when I was a young boy. In fact, I believe I went to Mass more with my grandmother than I did with my parents at a certain age of my life. These are important reminders of the significance the role of a grandparent or grandparents can have in a child's life.

The images of St. Anne and St. Joachim can give hope to all of us that God answers our prayers and needs. If we were to look at couples in Sacred Scripture, we would see that they were rewarded for faithfulness by God. We have Abraham and Sarah who were rewarded by God with a son because of their hospitality towards others.

In the New Testament, we have Elizabeth and Zechariah who were faithful as well to God. Their reward was of course a son, John the Baptist who heralded the coming of the Lord.

We do not read of St. Anne and St. Joachim in Scripture. They are mentioned in several writings which were never included in Sacred Scripture, but we can still believe that they were holy, righteous individuals who taught their daughter to love God and to cherish the birth of her Son.

The World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly allows us to give thanks for our grandparent, living and deceased. We can learn so much wisdom, experience, and guidance from them. We must remember to share this with all generations.
