A WORD FROM OUR PASTOR:

He Solemnity of Christ the King is different from other feasts in the Church's liturgical year. This Solemnity has not yet occurred, the coming of Christ in glory at the end of time. This weekend we also wrap up the Liturgical Year and complete the cycle of readings from Matthew. Next week, the first Sunday of Advent, we begin to read from the Gospel of St. Mark.

On this Feast Day of Christ the King, we may speak of endings but to be more specific, what we really celebrate is completion, the completion of the work of Christ and of the Church. The Church is not perfect, but the Church is Holy. She is made Holy by her mission to complete the work of Christ by being a sign of the Kingdom already present.

As we come to this weekend, we need to remind ourselves that the central task of the mission is to build the Kingdom, and the Eucharist is the Church's primary tool of unity. At each Mass, heaven and earth meet at the Altar. It may not always seem to be this way, given the human reality that not every Mass is as beautiful and as spiritual as we wish. People may be distracted, the homily may not be good, the music may not be the greatest. Despite all, Our Lord Jesus Christ comes and sits with each of us at every single Mass.

On this feast day of Christ the King, we are called to give ourselves over to our King who becomes visible at the Altar. In all that we think, day, or do, we are to call to mind Christ. He is the King who we are to believe in and follow.
