A Word From Our Pastor:

all will be upon us next week. The days are getting shorter, and the evenings come earlier. School has begun again for children. Most people are back to work after summer holidays. It is hard to believe that we are now in the last quarter of this year.

A couple of special holidays are fast approaching. We will be celebrating Thanksgiving in under a month. Christmas is only 14 weeks away!

Many will not realize that we as Catholics will be celebrating a special day in the next number of weeks. Counting this Sunday, in 10 weeks we will be celebrating the Feast of Christ the King. This feast celebrates something that has not yet happened, the second coming of Christ in all His glory.

Some of us may have already started to prepare for the Messiah to restore the Kingdom of Israel and to oust those who did not belong to the land. Yes, Jesus was the Messiah, and He did come to bring the Kingdom, but what the Kingdom would be was something far different than what was expected, and far greater.
