OUR SPIRITUAL JOURNEY

Lessons for Catholics of every Age!

Perhaps because of his intimate daily contact with the Mother of God, or because he was beloved, John's writing has an especially moving quality that shows his outstanding grasp of the profound meaning of every fact. In today's verses, his symbolic language reaches an apex of expressiveness.

Peter sets out to sea with six other companions on a nocturnal fishing venture. Jesus, from the shore, watches over them and the boat. They catch nothing. Jesus gives them directions and they obey, with astonishing results. Once again, Jesus' affirmation is verified: "Without Me, you can do nothing" (Jn 15:5), as well as that of St. Paul: "I can do all things in Him who strengthens me" Phil 4:13). These are the final lessons left by the Divine Master, not only for future centuries until the end of time — for us as well. When failure weighs upon our shoulders, let us seek to hear the voice of Jesus and follow His teachings. He, from the shore of eternity, will give us the wise and efficacious counsel that will transform our exhausting burden into marvelous success. Thus, we should never lose heart, despite the size of the obstacles to overcome.

Peter proposes the fishing excursion, leaps from the boat in search of Jesus, and returns to it to drag the net ashore. Here, Peter also represents the Pope of all times, the Sweet Christ on earth. To him befalls the direction of the Church, under the vigilance and orientation of Jesus.

The apostles had not eaten all night, but even before taking anything, they hand over the fruits of their labour to Jesus. This should always be our manner of acting; first we must return our successes to God, without concern for ourselves, because He will take the initiative of completing that which he Himself began. Let us embark on apostolic activities under the influence of the Holy Spirit, convinced that the captain of our boat is Peter. Our surrender and effort must be total. Jesus will provide us with nourishment and energy.
