Appearances after the Resurrection

"Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe." (John 20:29)

The Resurrection of Christ is the supreme proof of His divinity and the solid foundation of our Christian faith. St. Paul writes: "If Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain". (ICor 15:14)

After the resurrection, our Lord remained on earth for forty days during which time He appeared several times to His Apostles. Today's Gospel mentions two of those appearances of Jesus.

In the first appearance, Jesus bestows a very special power on His Apostles. While spreading the Good News they were to act in the name of God, for forgiving or not forgiving sin. "As the Father has sent me, even so I send you. Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained." (John 20:21, 22:23)

In the second appearance, our Lord convinces a doubting Thomas that it is really He, the Master, who is in the room. "Put your finger here, and see my hands; and put out your hand, and place it in my side; do not be faithless, but believing." Thomas answered Him, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said to him, "Have you believed because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe." (John 20:27-29)

The closing words of St. John clearly state the purpose for writing this Gospel. "These signs are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in His name." (John 20:31)

The facts surrounding the resurrection give so much more credence to our Lord's words uttered on other occasions during His public life. "I am the resurrection and the life; he who believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, and whoever lives and believes in me shall never die." (John 11:25-26)




