



### God's Invitation

Jesus could have remained with the Father in Heaven. He could have avoided all the aches and pains that come with having a human body. He could have avoided dying. But He chose to accept all those things to show God's love for us. Jesus didn't come charging into human affairs to force Himself on us and make us change. Rather, He invites us to Himself.

Today recalls our Lord's triumphal entrance into Jerusalem. He chose not the horse, but a lowly beast of burden to carry Him through the streets of the city, because the horse was the symbol of a conqueror, and the beast of burden reflected the animal of the poor. Jesus enter the city of Jerusalem as the King of peace, and the huge crowd gave Him recognition by spreading their cloaks on the road and cutting branches from the trees in order to lay them along His path. They cried out: "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord! Hosanna in the highest!" (Mt. 21:9)

In Baptism, we accepted that invitation, and Jesus came into our lives in a special way. Even now He comes to us. The season of Lent reminds us that Baptism is the first step on a long journey of faith. Each day brings more opportunities to follow Jesus and grow as Christians. As we do, like Christ some days will bring happiness as we help those in need and see instant success. Other days we may feel abandoned like Jesus in the Garden of Gesthane as we work hard in our home or ministry and no one seems to notice and other days when we stand up for our faith or morality, we may even be hated like Christ was during His passion.

But like Christ we keep our eyes on God the Father: On His love for us, we do all our acts in faith knowing that all our kindness and works brings us and those we minister to closer to God and like Christ we too can be assured that our faithfulness will end in the glory and joy that never ends.
