

AROUND THE ALTAR OF THE LORD The Communion Rite – "The Fraction"



The Fraction is the breaking of the bread (now becomes the Body of Christ) during the Lamb of God and "signifies that the many faithful are made one body (1 Cor 10:17) by receiving Communion

from the one Bread of Life which is Christ, who died and rose for the salvation of the world" (GIRM, 83). A piece of the broken Body of Christ is placed into the chalice with the Blood of Christ. Originally in the papal masses at Rome, the Pope would break off small pieces of the main host and a Deacon would carry it to all the priests who would celebrate Mass that day and they put it in their chalices as a way of showing that their Mass was done in union with the Pope. Mystically the mingling signifies the unity of the Body and Blood of the Lord in the work of salvation (Ibid).

While the body and blood are for us, presented separately, in the reality they are one. His body was given for us and from that body His most precious blood flowed forth to wash away our sins. The Fraction taking place while the faithful sing or recite the Lamb of God highlights the fact that forgiveness of sins came about through Christ's offering of Himself on the Cross. In the Old Testament, the lamb was a sacrificial animal that the High Priest would offer in remission of the sins of the people. Christ is the Lamb of God because He is offered for the remission of sins for all and for all times. Christ is also the High Priest because He is the one who offers the sacrifice. "No one takes my life from me," He tells Pilate in the Gospel of John. "I have power to lay down my life and power to take it up again".

The Fraction and Lamb of God remind the faithful of who they are about to receive. And the following prayer reminds the faithful of the humility with which they should approach the altar. The priest faces the people and holds up the Body of Christ and says, "This is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. Happy are those who are called to His supper." And the faithful reply, "Lord, I am not worthy to receive you, but only say the word and I shall be healed." The words of the priest recall the aspect of the Mass as participation in the heavenly banquet, that is eternal life in union with God who is the source and cause of all goodness and happiness. The faithful are truly very blessed to be invited to this banquet and should approach it with great thankfulness and praise to Him whose banquet it is. The response of the faithful, "Lord, I am not worthy," recalls the words of the centurion to Christ in the Gospel (Matt 8:8). Though the faithful know that they are infinitely unworthy to receive the gift that God offers, they also have faith that Christ has the power to heal them and make them worthy. So the members of the Church approach Christ and receive Him with humility knowing their unworthiness and with confidence acknowledging God's power to make worthy those whom He has called to receive Him.
