### Our Faith in the Resurrection

When Jesus first appeared to them, there was some hesitation and unbelief on the part of the disciples. They thought they were seeing a ghost, but Jesus reassured them when He said: "Handle me, and see; for a spirit has not flesh and bones as you see that I have." He stayed with them for the duration of the meal, "Have you anything here to eat?' They gave Him a piece of broiled fish, and He took it and ate before them." (Lk. 24:39, 41-43).

Hence, the hesitancy on the part of the disciples was only natural. They were not convinced until Jesus proved beyond any shadow of a doubt that He was really there with them in that chamber behind closed doors. He invited them to touch Him. He asked for food, which He ate in their presence. He proved to them all that it was really He, their Master, risen from the grave.

These encounters with the risen Savior turned out to be moments of personal grace and courage for the Apostles. During those forty days, Jesus came to remove their fears and to make clear the mission of salvation which He was entrusting to them. St. Luke describes very clearly the universality of their mission: "Penance for the remission of sins is to be preached to all the nations, beginning at Jerusalem. You are witnesses of this." (Luke 24:47-48)

The Savior of mankind did suffer and die, but He also rose from the dead on the third day. He appeared several times to His disciples to make sure that they understood what their mission was in the world. He had made Peter the rock upon which to build his Church. He now gives the Apostles power to preach the Good News of salvation and to baptize into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit; He also entrusted to them the faculty to absolve from sin in God's name. They also received the commission to change bread and wine into His body and blood and to partake of this spiritual nourishment which He gave "for the life of the world" (Jn. 6:51

How grateful must we be for all that our Savior has done for us! How obedient we must be to all that Jesus taught the Apostles and us! With St. Peter, let us proclaim: "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life; and we have believed, and have come to know, that you are the Holy One of God". (Jn 6:68-69)


