From the Desk of Father Boniface



Whom are you looking for? This question of St. Mary Magdalene has always fascinated me. When we came to Mass today, who did you think you would find. A friend, a miracle worker,

a leader, a confident, a social worker or simply a comfortable memory. St. Mary Magdalene came for that I think, a memory. She saw Jesus killed on the cross and buried. She came to weep for her friend who did so much for her.

But her hopes were more than fulfilled, amazingly so! It was hard for her to fully believe Jesus when He said, *"I will rise from the dead"*, these happenings are not part of the natural world, and even the appearance of angels could not completely break through her way of thinking. But Jesus is not only human; He is God, the second person of the Blessed Trinity. And He did indeed rise from the dead in a new and glorious form. He is alive! Death has no power over Him.
