AROUND THE ALTAR OF THE LORD <u>The Reception of Holy Communion</u>



All Baptized Catholics in communion with the Church and in the state of grace may receive Holy Communion. A Baptized Catholic is in union with the Church when they believe and confesse all that the Church believes and teaches. To be in the state of

grace is to possess the sacramental life of God in one's soul. This state is first achieved by Baptism but may be lost through mortal sin. Mortal sin is by definition a sin that kills the life of grace in the soul and separates the soul from God. The action of mortall sin involves the knowing and deliberate rejection of God and His law in a serious matter such that the individual rejects God as His maker and ruler of His life and as His saviour. Serious violations of the Ten Commandments and the Precepts of the Church all constitute mortal sins. One who has committed a mortal sin must receive forgiveness for that sin and make peace with God through the Sacrament of Confession before again receiving the Eucharist. Sacramental Confession requires contrition on the part of the sinner for the sin to be forgiven. Contrition involves sorrow for the sin and the resolution to try very hard not to sin again. One cannot thus receive forgiveness for sins that one intends to commit again. One should strive to achieve perfect contrition which is sorrow for one's sins because they are offensive to God who is all good and worthy of all of one's love.

The faithful are also required out of revereance for the Eucharist to abstain for an hour from eating before receiving Holy Communion. When receiving Holy Communion, one should make a gesture of reverence before receiving. Some recommended signs of reverence are genuflecting, bowing, or kneeling to receive. The priest will raise the Eucharist up before each person who approaches for Holy Communion and say the words: "The Body of Christ". To this, the communicant replies, "Amen", expressing their assent to the truth that Christ is truly present in the Eucharist and that he is in communion with the faith of the Church. One may receive Holy Communion either on the tongue or in the hand. One who chooses to receive Holy Communion by hand should form their hands into the shape of a throne for the Lord who is about to be placed upon them and very carefully place the Body of Christ in their mouth so as to prevent even the smallest particle from falling.
