The Procession

The Mass begins with the chanting and singing appropriate to the liturgical season intended to raise the minds of the faithful to the mysteries that they are about to celebrate (GIRM 28). The thurifer carries the the thurable where the incense is burned. As David says in the Psalms, May my prayer be like incense in your presence, my uplifted hands like the evening sacrifice, Psalms 141:2. The crucifer carries the cross, for we follow Christ. The cross is flanked by acolytes, or candle bearers, to bring attention to the cross, and to remind us that Jesus is the light of the world. Then follows the other altar servers, lectors, extraordinary ministers of communion (EMC) and other clergy, if there is a deacon, he will carry the book of the Gospel. The last person is the Priest who will offer the Mass and is known as the main celebrant. If there is another deacon, he will walk to the right of the main celebrant to assist him during Mass. A we are all members of the common priesthood because of baptism, the priest is a member of the congregation, specially chosen and consecrated to come from the congregation and lead the Mass on our behalf. The ministries who stay at the Altar around the Father represent each one of us around the Altar of God. This reminds us that we come here to devote ourselves to praise and worship God.
