### **One Flock – One Shepherd**

The early Christians loved the parable of the Good Shepherd so much that they used to paint on the walls of the catacombs the picture of Christ as the Good Shepherd, or as the Lamb of God.

In the East, where sheep seem to be more plentiful than in our own surroundings, the shepherd really gets to know his flock. The sheep often gather around him when he calls. He recognizes the bleat of most of the sheep. Because of his attachment to them, if a wolf approaches, the shepherd will stand his ground to protect the sheep. The hireling, on the other hand, who tends the sheep merely for the money he is being paid, will run as soon as danger confronts him.

Our Lord was then, is now, and will be in the future, the Good Shepherd of all peoples and races: *"There shall be one flock, one shepherd"* (Jn 10:16). He will always go after those who have gone astray – perhaps you and me, whenever sin has separated us from Him.

Jesus will always seek to remove the great scandal of division that exists today among the sheep, the Christians. He wants them all in one common union in the Church He founded, on St. Peter, the rock. And even the followers of the non-Christian religions, whom our Lord designates tenderly as "other sheep".

This, then, is the good news taken from today's Gospel: *"I am the good shepherd; and I lay down my life for the sheep. And I have other sheep, that are not of this fold; I must bring them also, and they will heed my voice. So there shall be one flock, one shepherd".* (Jn 10:14-16)
