TO BE RICH BEFORE GOD

If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on the things that are above not on things that are on earth, exhorts Saint Paul in the Second Reading of the Mass. ^{Col 3:1-5, 9-11} Nevertheless, the human heart has a tremendous capacity to seek the things of the world. The human hearts tends to become attached to worldly goods as the one and only goal in life, forgetting what is really important.

In today's Gospel, the Lord takes advantage of a question about inheritances to teach us about the true worth of things in the light of eternity. Luke 12:13-21 He brings up the subject of death, to make his point: The land of a rich man brought forth plentifully; and he thought to himself, 'What shall I do, for I have nowhere to store my crops?' And he said, 'I will do this: I will pull down my barns, and build larger ones...And I will say to my soul, Soul, you have ample goods laid up for many years; take your ease, eat, drink, be merry.' In this the rich man discloses his 'value system' in his mental dialogue. He sees himself in a very secure position because he has great resources. He bases his stability and his happiness on this wealth. For him, as for many people, living is a matter of enjoying as much pleasure as possible. Yet in the end, all of his calculations are for nothing. Note that Jesus never says that wealth or goods are bad, but that they in themselves cannot gain our true fulfillment, and love which comes from our union with Him knowing we use our gifts such as intelligence, health material goods, a capacity for friendship, the power to give joy to those around us. We use these gifts with detachment. They are not for us but given so that we can use them to build a culture of life and faith to be charitable and to spread love where we can. Fool is precisely what God calls the man who lives only for the world. We certainly have to walk with our feet on the ground, taking care to safeguard our future and the future of those who depend upon us. But we cannot forget that we are pilgrims. Worldly goods are but the means for us to attain the goal which the Lord has pointed out. These goods can never become the 'be-all and the-end all' of our existence.

Holy Martyrs of Japan Presents Pilgrimage to the Holy Land and Madrid World Youth Day – Spain 2011 14- day program from August 9th – August 22nd 2011

In brief, the trip consists of the following. (A more detail itinerary is available at the parish office).

Visit Mt. Carmel – drive to Tiberias & boat ride at the Sea of Galilee. Onwards to Capernaum, (Peter's Primacy) & motor coach to Mt. Beatitudes for a panoramic view of the Sea of Galilee and then onto the Baptismal Site at the Jordan River.

Drive to Nazareth to view St. Joseph's workshop & Mary's well. Onto Cana which is the site of Jesus' first miracle at the wedding feast, continue to the site of the Transfiguration at Mt. Tabor.

Church of St. Anne, marking the place of birth of the Blessed Mother, proceeding to the Chapel of the Flagellation (where Our Lord was scourged), afterwards a ride to Mt. Scopus and Mt. of Olives to gain a panoramic view of the old City of Jerusalem. Onto Church of All Nations in the Garden of Gethsemane and then to the Upper Room, commemorating the Last Supper.

Visiting Bethlehem in the morning and then the afternoon to the Yad Vashem Memorial Museum, telling the story of the Holocaust and serving a sober reminder of man's inhumanity to man. Madrid to experience the grandeur and charm of this city and then to the lavish Royal Palace and the city's huge Retiro Park.

Onto Principe Pio Hotel for the next 7 nights. Unlimited public transit pass to enjoy the sights of Madrid, then in the afternoon to the Opening Ceremonies. Then a pilgrimage to the site for the Overnight Vigil.

Cost per person in Canadian Dollars is two or three to a room is \$3,399.00. Single is \$3,900.00. A deposit of \$300.00 is due at the time of booking or by Sept 15, 2010.
