MISSION APPEAL FOR THE CATHOLIC DIOCESE OF ZARIA

The Diocese of Zaria is situated in Kaduna State, in Northern Nigeria. It has a population of over 70,000 Catholics who are mostly peasants and live on subsistence farming for their survival. Since the beginning of the diocese, we have struggled to sow the seed of the faith among our poor and vulnerable inhabitants, despite all the daunting challenges we face, especially in an area that is the stronghold of the Islamic religion in Nigeria and with a long history of Hausa/Fulani hegemony. The aim of participation in the Missionary Cooperative Plan (MCP) of the Archdiocese of Toronto is to raise awareness of the plight of the vulnerable population in the diocese of Zaria who live on the margin of society, who cannot afford basic necessities of life such as food, medicine and other basic necessities of life. Through the diocesan office of Justice and Peace, we have identified such families at parish levels and have tried to address their humanitarian concerns. However, the numbers of people in dire economic and social situations are daily on the increase because of dwindling family fortunes. Recent onslaught of the extremist Islamic sect, Boko Haram, in Nigeria have exacerbated the problem, with the attainment of the right to food a much more difficult task. Many people continue to flee conflicts zones leaving vast uncultivated lands that had hitherto served as the means of their sustenance. The majority of those suffering from hunger and malnutrition are small holders or landless people, mostly women and girls living in rural areas without access to productive resources. Whatever you can do to alleviate our plight - be it cash, medicine, clothing etc. will be a welcome boost. We look forward to your kind assistance as you help us ease the burdens of the poor and vulnerable of society.
