

Pre-Authorized Giving

REFLECTION

When John the Baptist announced the imminent coming of God's Anointed One, the Messiah, the religious leaders questioned his authority to speak so boldly in God's name. They asked him bluntly, "who are you?" and "What do you say about yourself?" They wanted to know if he was really sent by God. John had no doubt about his call and mission. In all humility and sincerity, he said he was only a voice bidding people to get ready for the arrival of the greatest Ruler of all, God's anointed King and Messiah. John the Baptist bridges the Old and New Testaments. He is the last of the Old Testament prophets who points the way to the Messiah. He is the first of the New Testament witnesses and martyrs. He is the herald who prepares the way for Jesus and who announces his mission to the people: Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world! (John 1:29). John saw from a distance what the Messiah would come to accomplish – our redemption from slavery to sin and out adoption as sons and daughters of God our heavenly Father. John was the greatest of the prophets, yet he lived as a humble and faithful servant of God. He pointed others to Jesus, the true Messiah and Savior of the world. REMINDERS

DISPENSATION FROM SUNDAY MASS: The

dispensation announced by Cardinal Collins, regarding the obligation to attend Mass on Sunday and holydays of obligation by parishioners during the time of the pandemic, is not a blanket dispensation, but one that applies when the faithful encounter certain life circumstances which physically or morally impede them from attending Mass. Physical and moral impediments include: Closure of one's parish church or reduction of number of Masses on Sunday or holy days of obligation due to Covid-19 conditions, closure of all parishes in an area or region due to Covid-19, being ill or caring for someone who is ill, and being homebound or hospital-bound; feeling symptomatic with the Covid-19 virus; needing to self-isolate due to a Covid-19 related contact; attempting to register for Mass, but the registration is full; arriving at a parish and being told that the church is at capacity; being of a certain age and/or having an underlying health condition and feeling vulnerable to the virus because of know and serious consequences, despite an otherwise healthy disposition; having a genuine grave fear of the Covid-19 virus and not desiring to be at any place where people gather.

ON-LINE DONATIONS

It continues to be a challenge for our parish to maintain operations without the weekly offertory collection. We are most thankful for your continued and anticipated support during this difficult time.

SACRAMENTS

BAPTISMS: Baptism Packages can be picked up after attending any Mass. Take the package home, complete the forms and return it after attending any Mass to clergy. A clergy member will be in touch with you to discuss details and to confirm a date.

FIRST COMMUNION & CONFIRMATION:

Emails were sent out back in August to book a date and time through Eventbrite for those who pre-registered to receive the Sacrament of Communion (our current grade 3's). Due to the lack of interest, as the dates and times offered did not fill, no additional dates for Communion were released. Those still waiting to receive the sacrament (current grade 3's), who did not register for the dates that were made available via Eventbrite, please come to any of our Masses, weekday or weekend, and speak to Fr. Joshua or any of the clergy, regarding the Sacrament.

We have completed the Sacrament of Confirmation for those students who pre-registered last year (our now grade 8's). Two sets of Confirmation dates have been released via email along with a link to register for your date through Eventbrite. Congratulations to our confirmandi and families.

For our current grade 2's and 7's, wishing to receive First Holy Communion and Confirmation, the plan is to have a parent meeting in January, so that we can carefully plan and prepare the materials needed to assist you and your family on this journey. All will be communicated to you through whatever means we have. We invite you to come to Mass, watch it on youtube, or go to our website for any further updates or announcements.
