#### GAUDETE (REJOICE) SUNDAY

Today we light a rose-colored candle in the Advent wreath, a mark of *Gaudete* ("rejoice") Sunday. As we have now passed the mid-point of this penitential season, we breathe a little easier and our anticipation rises as we await the coming of our Lord at Christmas. Our scripture readings today are infused with both joy and encouragement. "Be strong, do not fear," says the prophet (Isaiah 35:4). James urges us to be patient and strengthen our hearts. The psalmist extolls our God, who loves us unconditionally, who is just and compassionate for the prisoner, the hungry and the sick. In the lives we lead at work or home, we begin to feel a certain intensity to this season. The grind lessens, the daily tasks seem somewhat beside the point.

Almost unconsciously, people are kinder to one another. The mood lightens noticeably. We feel that Christmas is just around the corner. But still in Advent we pray, "O Lord, fill us with courage and strength to stay on that straight path as we await your coming.
