THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

As we enter the 2^{nd} half of Advent, we turn our focus onto the Lord's first Coming at Christmas. In the second half, the Gospels will turn to John the Baptist this week, and Our Blessed Mother next week – both of whom are important in proclaiming the arrival of the Lord.
