Merry Christmas

IN FRONT OF THE MANGER

I am writing this note as I am looking at the nativity scene in the rectory. I wonder what the people there were thinking; the wise men who saw His star and had the idea form in their mind. This boy will change everything. It will be a new world now. What faith, they needed to trust that idea, to leave their homes and put their lives on hold to go and worship the world's Saviour the King of kings.

I wonder about the shepherds, were they still shocked from seeing the vision of angels announcing the birth of the long expected Messiah. Did they wonder why it was shared with the then, the lowliest members of their society. What could this herald, they wondered, a king who cares for us? I think about Mary and Joseph. They knew who this child was. On the one hand Jesus needed Joseph to protect Him and he reached out his hand to Mary his mother, while with the other hand He held all of creation in existence. Most of all I wonder about Jesus and how much love He had for us to enter His own creation, and be one of us. How he could freely give up His glory in heaven to be born in such a lowly estate, so He could be accessible to all. The rich wise kings, the poor and lowly shepherds.

I think that all the wonder that the people around Jesus experienced produced stillness and quiet. "Silent night, Holy night, all is calm, all is bright". They were there in silence, but more so in love, they left their world, their lives behind and just let Jesus love them and they loved Him back. This produced peace, for this is why we were created, to be with the Lord. God so loved the idea of us that He made us real, at our heart there is a uniqueness never to be replicated and when you love Him you love Jesus in a way only you can in the uniqueness and we make His love more manifest in the world. When we can do this we fulfill our deepest desire, our reason for being, and we are at peace. That peace produces in us joy. "It is good for us to be here" says St. Peter at the transfiguration when he sees Jesus in all His divinity (Lk 9:33) and it produces a closeness that nothing else can replicate because it is founded on divine love. You know for all the wealth given Jesus, no evidence exists he had a privileged life. I think the fathers of church were right, that Mary gave away the treasures she received to the poor, like those shepherds, because in their closeness they were truly a family in Christ and they needed the help more than Mary and Joseph. Peace, joy and good will is felt so much this season for Christ is really here close to us, visiting us right now.

To leave our world or put our life on hold to travel to Him, may at first seem daunting and scary, will He be there in that church waiting for me? Perhaps we feel it is too much of a burden to make a journey, but this is the promise of Christmas 'I'm really here says Jesus' "come to me all you who are weary and carrying heavy burdens and I will give you rest" (Mt 11:28). Trust in the Lord and He will not disappoint you. And the hope that I have is that we can take these feelings of peace, joy and goodwill and hold on to them tight, keep them all year round. For this Christmas spirit can change the world for the better.


