PREPARE THE WAY

In the Gospel the power of John the Baptist brings judgment and purification to work within us. "Prepare the way of the Lord, straighten out His paths," the Baptist tells us; behind his word is the image, which the ancients so well know, of a royal entrée. Without trains or cars the ancient king, like any subjects, had many days to spend on his beast or in his carriage, and rough roads made his way more difficult. So scores of servants were put to work preparing his way. That is the image; the mystery happens to us; Christ, the King, comes. It is our task to prepare His way to our inmost depth of mind. We are to make low the mountains of pride and hills of stubbornness which the Lord has no mind to pass over. We are to fill up the valleys of unbelief and despondency; we are to be conscious of our weakness and sinfulness, but full of faith in His power to purify and make us holy; to work change in us, and to divinize; and all of this when He comes to us in ritual. When He calls, and we hear Him with ready heart, His Word, will accomplish its work, the marvel of cleansing and the forgiving of sin. In our souls every valley is filled with the fruits He gives it, and every high place of human greatness casts itself down in humble fear knowing that it can have nothing incorruptible. This attitude is that of the virgin and the bride; it is proper, then, to Christ's bride, the Church. Mary is the type of her, the virgin and servant of the Lord. She gave her fiat, full of faith and love, and thereby made the way open for grace to come into the world. The power of God could flow into her, and she could bear God's Son, because, as Saint Leo the Great said, "She had first received the God-man as a child in spirit, before she did in body."
