

A WILDERNESS IN ONE'S HEART

In salvation history, the wilderness or desert held a painful yet privileged position. It recalled Israel's period of testing and rebellion, which had also proven to be a place of grace and revelation. To go into the wilderness, then, meant facing one's fragility, one's weakness and sin and, in doing so, we experience the corresponding possibility of repentance and renewal.

Life in the wilderness forces a person to focus on the basics: the need for water and shelter against the heat. Solidarity with fellow pilgrims on the journey and hospitality to strangers become core values. The trails associated with survival bring out the best and the worst in people. The unremitting demands of the desert uncover the hardness of one's heart, as well as the potential to call to God in our need.

John the Baptist humbly wanted to open his hearers to such realities when he preached "a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins".

Advent invites Catholics to make the wilderness an interior experience that touches their hearts, leading them to discover God's call to repentance, to a renewed offer of forgiveness and to new life of humble devotion and prayer.
