REFLECTION

As we begin to approach the holy season of Lent, the Church calls us to reflect upon what it means to be the light of the world. By virtue of our baptism, we are all called to consecrate our life by living out the Gospel message and to go and proclaim this good news to the world.

Sometimes, we interpret this message and good news negatively, especially when it comes to the commandments and the "law of God." However, Our Lord sheds lights upon these commandments as the way that we are truly set free from our sins, sorrows, worries, and anxieties. Jesus wants us to be free of all burdens, so He reveals us the formula on how to love like God. The Commandments, the Beatitudes, all the teachings of the Church, are meant to show us on how to bring divine love into the world.

The Grade 7s, our confirmandi, have been studying, praying, and reflecting on the reasons why they have been baptized, and how the Sacrament of Confirmation will complete their initiation into the Church. Like all sacraments, God is the one who bestows this gift to all who seek Him with a sincere heart. Just as God is the one who baptizes, forgives, gives His body and blood, He is also the one who is confirming the confirmandi into His love, so that they can live out the vocation and mission God is calling them to.
