

#### SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Jesus tells us that we must be perfect as our heavenly Father is perfect. We must not act like hypocrites by following the example or words of those who say: "You shall love your neighbour and hate your enemy" (Mt. 5:43). "Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you..."(Mt.5:44) are the powerful words of Jesus. All this will prove that you are sons and daughters of your heavenly Father. In a word, Jesus commands us to love all of God's children, that is, the good and the bad, the just and the unjust, without making distinctions of race, color or creed. If we do not follow this command of Jesus then we cannot say we truly love God. The love of God, and the love of His children, our neighbours, are two precepts which cannot be separated because one depends upon the other. Loving our neighbour, no matter who they are, or what they have done, is a sure sign that we love God. God's love is all embracing; and we must not set limits to our acts of love. This all-powerful force in the universe was given to us by God to lift our soul to heaven. We must love all of God's children in word and action.

How do we love our brothers and sisters? Jesus tells us to render good for evil. He wants us to help the poor and those who are badly in need of the necessities of life. He wants us to console the afflicted, and to bring joy to the sick, the lonely, the elderly and to anyone who is suffering with a heavy cross. He wants us to help our enemies, even those who have caused us to suffer. He wants us to help convert the sinner by our good words and edifying example.
