THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

SITTING WITH SCRIPTURE

When Jesus was carried into the Jerusalem Temple and the old man Simeon say the Baby, something within him lit up. He embraced the Child in his arms and said a prayer that has become the Church's daily night prayer called the Song of Simeon. "Now, Lord You can let me go. You have kept Your word. I have seen Your salvation. He will be a light to the Gentiles as well as the glory of Israel." Simeon represents all the Old Testament holy ones who were looking for the Messiah. In the words of Simeon we have the echo of Abraham, Jacob, Moses, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel and Malachi. When Simeon looked at Jesus, it was as though old Israel was speaking. "Lord, You can let us go in peace. The work of the old covenant is finished." The revelation, the Law and the rituals that Israel kept alive will now pass into Jesus as He fulfills and completes everything they represented. This moment is like the baton being handed over in a race. Jesus will be the new Israel and the real glory of Israel. As Christians we should read the Old Testament. They record for all time and for all humanity the great events that point to our redemption in Jesus. If the Old Testament helps us understand the New because it embodies Jesus' heritage from which He drew, the New Testament shows us the fulfillment of the Old because the one God reveals Himself throughout. Further, the Old Testament is not only about the great national drama of Israel but also about the story of every soul seeking salvation. The Presentation of the Lord is not only a moment of fulfillment but also a moment of hope. Jesus is the glory of Israel and a light to the Gentiles. Jesus embodies the hope of forgiveness, new life, second birth and eternal life for people of every nation and culture. He is indeed light to the Gentiles and light at every stage of our life.


