#### REFLECTION

In the Old testament 40 days was often seen as a significant period of testing and preparation for entering into a covenant relationship with God. God tested Abraham to prove his faith. The Israelites were sorely tested in Egypt before God delivered them from their enemies. Jesus was no exception to this testing. After Jesus was anointed by the Spirit in the waters the Jordan River, he journeyed to the wilderness of Judea for 40 days to prepare himself for the mission of which the Father sent him to accomplish – to offer his life as the perfect atoning sacrifice for our sins. Satan did his best to entice Jesus to choose his own will over the will of his Father in heaven. Despite his weakened condition, due to fatigue and lack of food for 40 days, Jesus steadfastly rejected Satan's subtle and not so subtle temptations. Where did Jesus find his strength to survive the desert's harsh conditions and tempter's seduction? He fed on his Father's word and found strength in doing his will. Satan will surely tempt us and will try his best to get us to choose our will over God's will.

How do we enter the kingdom of God? In announcing the good news of the Gospel, Jesus gave two explicit things each of us must do in order to receive the kingdom of God: *Repent and Believe*.

Repentance is the first step to surrendering my will and my life to God. Repent means to turn away from sin and wrong-doing, to change my way of thinking, my attitude, my disposition, and the way I choose to live my life, to a way that honors and glorifies HIM. To follow God's way of love, truth and moral goodness. Whatever stands in the way of God's will and plan for my life must be surrendered to him-my sinful pride, my rebellious attitude and stubborn will to do as I please rather that which pleases HIM. If I am only sorry for the consequences of my own sinful ways, I will very likely keep repeating the same sins. True repentance requires a contrite heart and true sorrow for sins (Psalms 51:17) and a firm resolution to sin no more.

To *Believe* is to take Jesus at his word and recognize that God loved us so much that he sent his only begotten Son to free us from bondage to sin and harmful desires. God made the supreme sacrifice of his Son to bring us back to a relationship of peace, friendship and unity with Him. He is our Father and he wants us to live in joy and freedom as his *beloved* sons and daughters.
