EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

TODAY'S TASK

Our Lord counsels us in today's Gospel: Do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring worries of its own. Today's trouble is enough for today. Matt 6:34

There are no grounds, objectively speaking, for letting worry and concern for tomorrow weigh us down: we will be given the graces we need in order to contend with anything that crops up. In the end, we will be victorious! What matters is *today*. Today is the day we need in which to love, to grow in holiness, through those countless little occurrences that go to make up the texture of our life. Some things will be naturally pleasant, others perhaps less gratifying, but each one of them can be made to shine for God and for eternity, a gem which we will have wrought and polished with human perfection and supernatural meaning.

We cannot dally with wishful thinking. Sometimes our fanciful imagination improves upon the reality of past events and enslaves us by idealizing a future reassuringly free from effort; or it may, on the contrary, show us a dark horizon, a prospect that makes us apprehensive. He who observes the wind will not sow; and he who regards the clouds will not reap. Eccles 11:4

Do not be anxious....Fruitless worry does not cancel out the misfortune we dread, but foolishly goes out to meet it. We shoulder a burden without yet having received the grace of God would give to enable us to carry it. Worry magnifies the difficulties and diminishes our ability to fulfill the duty of the present moment. Above all, we fail to trust in the Providence God exercises over every situation in life. In the First Reading of today's Mass our Lord asks us in the words of the prophet Isaiah: Can a woman forget her child or show no compassion for the child of her womb? Yet even if she forgets, I will not forget you, says the Lord. Is 49.14-15 Today, in all that happens, our Father God will think of us with love.

And Jesus has reminded us so often already! *Take heart*, He says, *it is I, have no fear*. Matt 14:27 We cannot carry at the same time the cares of today and the worries of tomorrow. We always have sufficient help to be faithful today, to live this particular day with peace and joy.

Living Lent

<u>Purpose of Lent today</u>: Lent is a time of prayer and penance, when Christ wants to lead us back to our baptismal promises of dying to sin and of living for God. We prepare ourselves to enter once again into Jesus' Paschal mystery and to renew it in our lives.

<u>Christians</u>: From the earliest centuries, Jesus' followers have tried to follow these commands. Since it was on a Friday that Jesus freely died to save us from our sins, the faithful made a special effort to do some form of penance on this day: going without food for most of the day, spending extra time in prayer, doing good works, refraining from eating meat. Like St. Paul, they wanted to offer their penances for Christ's body, the Church. (Collossians 1.24)

<u>In today's Church</u>: Over the centuries, these forms of penance have varied, and sometimes have been neglected. Today, we are being invited once more to obey our Saviour: we are to do penance for our sins and those of others, for the people of God, for peace in the world, and for the building up of God's kingdom on earth. So to make Lent an effective time of renewal for the great celebration of Easter, let us commit ourselves to the practices of Lent.

Praying: Jesus and His apostles tell us to pray always, to be constant in prayer. Traditional times for Christians to pray are morning, evening and mealtimes. Personal prayer is a necessary preparation for our sharing in the Church's public worship, the liturgy. In our love, we join Jesus and all God's people in praying for ourselves, for our family and friends, for our leaders, for those who suffer, and for the Church and the world.

Fasting: Fasting means cutting down on the amount and richness of our food and drink. Done as a penance for sin, it helps us to pray better: an empty stomach can lead to more attentive prayer. The money we save on food should be given to others in alms. The law of fasting obliges adults until they are 60 years old.

<u>Abstinence</u>: This form of penance needs to be seen as a near cousin of fasting. We may give up meat especially on Fridays, the day of Christ's saving death on the cross. Our abstinence is another way of sharing in Christ's work of saving the world. We may also substitute other good actions for abstinence from meat. These could include special acts of charity (visiting the sick or aged, helping those in any need, contributing time or money to a work of charity) or other acts of piety.

Giving alms: We give alms to help God's poor and to support the good works of the Church and other positive agencies. Again our help is being given to Christ in His brothers and sisters. Blessed Teresa of Calcutta when asked how much to give *"give until your can feel it"*. We do not give in order to show off or keep up with others; instead we give cheerfully to God, who has given us everything we have.
