



Around the Altar of the Lord

Liturgy of the Eucharist –
The Eucharistic Prayers

The First Eucharistic Prayer, also known as the Roman Canon, was the only one in use in the Roman Rite before the Second Vatican Council. This Eucharistic Prayer comes down to us almost exactly the same as it was when St. Ambrose of Milan prayed it in the fourth century and referred to it as already of long use in the Church in Rome: (Ambrose De Sacramentis). A distinctive characteristic of the Roman Canon is the litany of Roman martyrs and other martyrs venerated in Rome from the early persecutions of the Church. This gives the prayer its name. Canon is Greek for a list, namely the "List" of martyrs invoked at Rome. The Church of Rome invoked the saints who died for her in the Eucharistic Prayer very fittingly because the martyrs participate in the heavenly Liturgy that the Church on earth participates in through the Holy Mass. The use of the same Eucharistic Prayer as that used by the Church in Rome expresses very strongly unity with and the fidelity to the Pope. The Second Eucharist Prayer also has ancient but less certain origins. The text of the prayer itself is derived from the third century work *The Apostolic Tradition*, attributed to St. Hippolytus of Rome. It was not a commonly used Eucharistic Prayer in the Church in the West before the Second Vatican Council. The third Eucharistic prayer is not ancient at all but has in fact been composed since the Second Vatican Council in the 1960s. It is modeled on the Roman Canon while taking elements from other Eucharist prayers including those of other Rites within the Church. The fourth Eucharistic Prayer is modeled on that of St. Basil who lived in the 6th Century. It is very noticeably different in parts from the other Eucharistic Prayers particularly by its extended narration of salvation history. Other Eucharistic Prayers have also been written, two for reconciliation (used in Advent and Lent mostly), and two for Masses with children. Four others written in Switzerland, obviously called the Swiss Canons, are also approved and may find general usage in the Church as time goes on.

ANOINTING MASS (World day of the Sick) Thursday,

February 11th at 7:00pm

Those who are sick have always had a special place in the Church's ministry of compassion. We can all remember seeing a loved one who is sick and wishing that we could do something for them. Jesus Himself, spent much of His ministry curing all those who were ill. This was carried out in the Church, as seen by the words in the epistle of St. James "are there any who are sick among you, let them send for the priests of the Church and the priest will pray over them, anointing them with the oil in the name of the Lord and the prayer of faith will save the sick person." St. Thomas Aquinas would go on to say that the sacrament gives us the grace to accept the will of God in this time of life, whether it be for healing or to accept our cross without it becoming burdensome. The sacrament raises up and strengthens the soul as it is enflamed by Christ's divine mercy.

On this day for the sick, we too commend to Christ's mercy all who are in serious ill (beyond that with an assured cure) or who are of advanced age, and would like to offer them anointing during the celebration of Mass. Also, even if you are not in need of the sacrament, we encourage all who can to come to Mass and add their prayers and support.
