

BAPTISM OF THE LORD

At the Jordan River, Jesus began His public life. Today, we leave Bethlehem and go to what the liturgical books call the ordinary time of the year. Jesus comes as an adult to the Jordan River to fulfill the promise of Bethlehem and to begin the public teaching, healing, forgiving, finding and repairing He was born to do. He starts by being baptised or washed as a sign not of washing sin away, but of a new phase of His life, as if to say, 'It is now time to put away the private life of Nazareth and to do everything the Father asks of me.' What a good lesson for all who call God our Father.

Christmas is a wonderful season, as is the day of our Baptism. But the place where we become saints and make a Christian impact is not at our baptismal font but in the years that follow. That life of Christ shown is us whenever we come to the Lord in prayer, whenever we resist evil, whenever we uphold truth, or defend human life, whenever we bear adversity patiently, whenever we promote peace, or whenever we reach out in charity to others.

For that, our world needs strong, Christian adults - firm in faith, clear in values, anchored in the Lord, powered by grace, vigorous in mission,, sturdy in hope. This doesn't happen all at once at a baptismal font. It begins there, but strong Christians grow as the seeds sown in Baptism are brought to life in ordinary time as we come to Mass weekly, receive the sacraments, are constant in prayer, learn how to give witness. That is how we grow strong in Christ.


