

THE SACREMENT OF INITIATION

John the Baptist was our Lord's second cousin, six months older than Jesus. John had been selected by God for a very special mission in the world. He was to prepare the way for the coming of Christ. This he did by preaching penance that would reform people's lives, because "the kingdom of heaven is at hand" (Mt. 3:2). John baptized with water to symbolize the washing away of sin in those who were sincerely repentant. He told his listeners that the one "who is mightier than I, will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire" (Lk 3:16).

The liturgy today tells us that Jesus came from Nazareth and asked His cousin to baptize Him, even though He had no need for Baptism. It was His way of revealing His true identity with His eternal Father and the Holy Spirit. "And when He came up out of the water, immediately He saw the heavens opened and the Spirit descending upon Him like a dove; and a voice came from heaven, 'You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased'. (Mk 1:10-11). The Blessed Trinity is clearly manifested on this occasion.

By receiving this baptism, our Lord sets an example for all to follow. Water has cleansing power, and when used in the name of the Blessed Trinity, it cleanses the soul of all sins. In a short while Jesus would commission His Apostles to "make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" (Mt. 28:19). And this was to be done because "unless one is born anew, he cannot see the kingdom of God" (Jn 3:3).




