Around the Altar of the Lord



<u>Liturgy of the Eucharist –</u> <u>Preparation of the Gifts</u>

The Liturgy of the Eucharist takes place at the Altar where the priest acting as Christ Himself (in persona Christi) makes present the Last Supper and the passion and death of Our Lord on the cross. As in

the Last Supper, the priest uses bread and wine which become the Body and Blood of Christ. Members of the faithful carry the offerings to the priest standing at the foot of the Sanctuary. This action has symbolic significance in a number of ways. demonstrates the participation of the faithful in the sacrifice and recalls the thanksgiving sacrifices of the Old Testament which were in the form of bread and wine. By the presentation of the offerings, the faithful demonstrate their thankfulness to Christ for having saved them from eternal death because of their sins, just as the Old Testament patriarches expressed their thankfulness for preservation from physical death by offerings of bread and wine (Lev 7:12). The chalice is placed on the altar at this time and it is unveiled (the chalice veil colour follows the liturgical season like the vestments of the priest and the altar). The act of removing the chalice veil symbolizes the stripping from Christ of His garments before He was nailed to the cross. A drop of water is added to the wine as the priest quietly says "by the mingling of this water and wine may we come to share the divinity of Christ who humbled Himself to share in our humanity". This is the central action of the offertory. We spirituality place ourselves on the altar and pray that we who are here become more and more Christ-like by the presence of God at this Mass. We too want to lose ourselves in Christ's presence, fully seen at the Concecration just like that little drop of water mingles and looses itself in the wine.

After the initial prayer of offering over the bread and wine by the priest, he may incense them as well as "the cross and the altar itself, so as to signify the Church's offering and prayer rising like incense in the sight of God. Next, the priest, because of his sacred ministry, and the people, by reason of their baptismal dignity, may be incensed" (GIRM 75). After the incensing, the servers wash the priest's hands while the priest prays for purification from his sinfulness. The exterior cleansing signifies the desired interior prification. While the priest offering of the sacrament is always valid, for Christ acts through him. He desires to be as worthy as possible for indeed Christ does work through him.

INTRODUCING FATHER JOSEPH



Dear Brothers and Sister in Christ, I would like to introduce myself: My name is Father Joseph Lam Tran. I was born in Vietnam in 1945. I was ordained as a priest in 1974, in Saigon, Vietnam. In 1975 after the fall of Saigon by communist invasion, I worked as Associate Pastor at Tuc

Trung Parish, Diocese of Xualonc.

In 1987, I escaped Vietnam by land to go to Campuchia and then by boat to Thailand. My escape is the result of being threaten, to be put in jail by the communist Regime. In 1988 I reached Thailand only to be stranded in a refugee camp for three and a half years. During this time I said Masses to Vietnamese Catholics with the permission of the Nuncio of Bangkok.

I was accepted by the Canadian Delegation to come to Canada and arrived in 1991. I was a Pastor in a Vietnamese Parish in Toronto for ten years and as an Associate Pastor at Saint Bernadette, in Ajax for 6 years. For the past two years I was with the Vietnamese Catholic Community in Ottawa. I have now been appointed to be the Associate Pastor for Father Boniface by Archbishop Thomas Collins. I feel happy and ready to work with Father Boniface and to serve you all. Please pray for me that I will be of good service to you, God's people of this lovely parish. I want to wish a Happy New Year to you all.
