#### GOD INSTITUTED MARRIAGE

The "public life" of Jesus began with His baptism in the River Jordan at the hands of His cousin, John the Baptist. After this He retired to the desert where He fasted and prayed for forty days and was tempted by the devil. He next began to gather around Him some disciples, and from these He chose the twelve Apostles. His first miracle took place at a marriage feast in Cana of Galilee, to which He and His disciples had been invited, along with His Mother.

Jesus is present at a marriage! Why not? Although not married, He certainly had no objection to offer against it. His heavenly Father was the one who decided on this union in the first place in the Garden of Eden. The Lord God said: "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for him" (Gn 2:18). "Therefore a man leaves his father and his mother and cleaves to his wife, and they become one flesh" (Gn 2:24). Yes, God created man in His image "Male and female he created them. And God blessed them and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth and subdue it" (Gn 1:27-28).

The presence of Jesus at the wedding in Cana indicated that it certainly had His approval, and the miracle He performed was, indeed, a great favour that He conferred on this young couple – a favour which was symbolic of the many other graces and favours which are received in the sacrament of Matrimony. Yes, there will be disagreement and conflicts at times, but the young man and woman have expressed their willingness to accept all "for better, for worse, in sickness and in health, until death". Divorce is not the solution to the problem. Rather, turn to Jesus and Mary for inspiration, courage and strength to help solve those martial problems.

Learn to invite Jesus to the marriage feast first of all, and then do all in your power to keep Him in your home all the days of your life. Marriage can be a beautiful thing. Yes, every rose may have its thorns. Long suffering and patience in accepting thorns will one day add much fragrance to an already beautiful thing – marriage, because Christ and His blessed Mother were invited to the feast and were asked to remain in the home.
