SITTING WITH SCRIPTURE

"Let both grow together until the harvest; and at harvest time I will tell the reapers, Gather the weeds first and bind them in bundles to be burned, but gather the wheat into my barn"(Mt. 13-30). If he pulled out the bad plants, he might also destroy the good ones. And so, he decided to allow both plants to grow side by side, and at the harvest time he would direct his helpers first to gather the weeds first to be burned, and then the wheat to be stored in his barn. The Son of Man is the sower of good seed, that is, of good and holy affections, of good and lawful enjoyments, of good and praiseworthy thoughts and desires, of all that is good and pleasing to His heavenly Father. Satan, on the other hand, is the enemy of both God and His creatures. It is Satan who sows the bad seed in the form of uncontrolled desires and affections, in the form of temptations to violate the laws of God. of the harvest, as the Gospel calls it, the good and the wicked will receive their just merit and demerit. Among which group will Jesus find you and me? This will depend on how we have grown in the world - as good seed or bad. God leaves the choice up to us. St. Augustine stated the same thing when he wrote: "God who made you without your cooperation will not save you without your cooperation."
